# USNH Potluck/Cinema “We Bought a Zoo” Friday, January 10

The February discussion will be on Saturday, February 15 at 2:00 p.m. In case of bad weather, the backup date will be Saturday, February 22 at 2:00 p.m..

Both books are widely available at public libraries and at online and retail bookstores. Refreshments will be served.
